Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) considered proposals for criteria for cases of failure to submit information relating to estimates of greenhouse gas emissions by sources and removals by sinks from activities under Article 3, paragraphs 3 and 4, of the Kyoto Protocol contained in documents FCCC/SBSTA/2005/MISC.13 and Add.1.
2. The SBSTA agreed to recommend a draft decision on this matter (FCCC/SBSTA/2005/L.18/Add.1) for adoption by the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of Parties to the Kyoto Protocol at its first session.
