Opening

The sessions of the Ad Hoc Working Group on Further Commitments for Annex I Parties under the Kyoto Protocol (AWG) and the Ad Hoc Working Group on Long-term Cooperative Action under the Convention (AWGLCA) will commence with an opening ceremony attended by the Deputy Prime Minister of the Kingdom of Thailand, His Excellency Mr. Sahas Bunditkul. The meeting will also be addressed by Ms. Noeleen Heyzer, Under Secretary-General of the United Nations and Executive Secretary of the Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific. A video message from Mr. Ban Ki-moon, Secretary-General of the United Nations will follow. Further addresses will be made by His Excellency Mr. Rachmat Witoelar, Minister of Environment of the Republic of Indonesia followed by Mr. Yvo de Boer, UNFCCC Executive Secretary, whose address will conclude the opening ceremony.

The opening will start promptly at 10.00 in Plenary I. Participants are asked to take their seats by 09.45. The doors of Plenary will be CLOSED at that time! The proceedings can also be followed on the CCTV monitors around the conference venue. Three seats will be available per delegation. A number of additional seats will also be available on a first come, first served basis.
