### **Policy and budgetary implications of funding the travel and participation in meetings of the constituted bodies of all members and alternate members**

#### **Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair**

1. The Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) recalled decisions 27/CMP.1, 4/CMP.2 and 4/CMP.4.
2. The SBI also recalled decisions 1/CP.16, 2/CP.17 and 4/CP.17.
3. The SBI took into account the recommendations made by the Compliance Committee in its annual reports.<sup>1</sup>
4. The SBI considered the report on the policy and budgetary implications of funding the travel and participation in meetings of the constituted bodies of all members and alternate members requested in decision 12/CMP.7 and contained in document FCCC/SBI/2012/INF.1.
5. The SBI took note of the estimated budgetary implications of extending funding for the travel and participation in meetings of the constituted bodies to all members and alternate members, as provided by the secretariat.
6. The SBI recommended to the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol for its consideration that the current practice relating to funding for travel-related expenditures of members and alternate members of the constituted bodies be maintained.
