Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

1. The Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) took note of the views of Parties on privileges and immunities for individuals serving on constituted bodies established under the Convention. It also took note of the draft treaty arrangements on privileges and immunities for individuals serving on constituted bodies established under the Kyoto Protocol.¹
2. The SBI agreed to continue its consideration of privileges and immunities for individuals serving on constituted bodies established under the Convention at SBI 44 (May 2016).
