Transport Services

Public Transport

The Government of France provides free 'Navigo' local transportation passes to each accredited participant (one-week passes for registered representatives of observer organizations for each week they are accredited for and two-week passes for all other accredited participants). The pass allows to use all public transportation within Paris and from Roissy to Paris or Le Bourget (and vice versa), including the RER, Metro, and the following buses:
