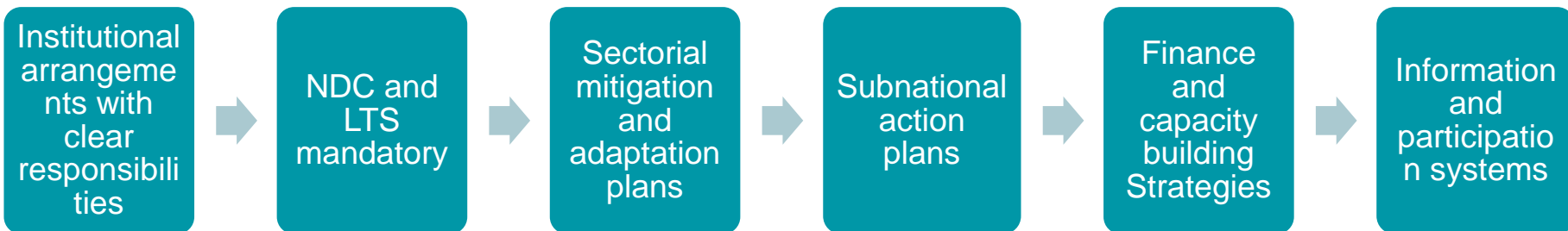

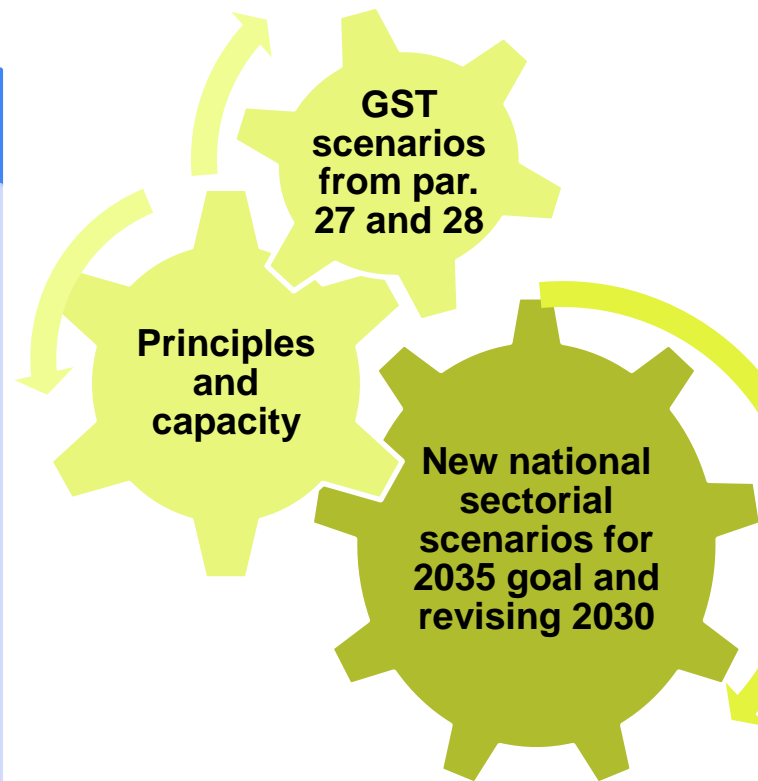

Lessons and other considerations

- The process for elaboration is regulated by our law, it will take one year, it considers different spaces for participation and in the process it includes the participation of sectorial ministries and also finance, social development, and gender ministries.
- We will visit each paragraph of the GST1 outcome, and state our commitment to each being as ambitious as we can considering our national circumstances. This will be reflected in the ICTU contents.
- Implementation of our NDC 2020 is in some aspects slower than expected, but this should not compromise our ambition, although it advises us to consider more realistic scenarios, it helps us to detect our barriers and work on them.
- For implementation, legislative framework and institutional arrangements are in place, however to get where we need is slow, other socioeconomic barriers have to be considered and capacities and financial mechanisms need to be built.
