Participation of Zimbabwe will result in the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions and the enhancement of removals at the same time attracting private sector financing into low emission climate resilient programming. Activities are expected to improve air quality, natural ecosystem resilience, waste management, sustainable energy provision, cleaner production, energy efficiency and agriculture productivity amongst other sustainable development benefits.

All projects are expected to contribute to and automatically retire a proportion of their mitigation outcomes towards the country's NDC. In addition, and if required, the government can cede a proportion of its share of proceeds towards NDC achievement. Projects implemented outside the NDC will contribute to the LT-LEDS or the other broader climate change objectives.

Sustainable development benefits of projects will contribute towards the adaptation component of the NDC and climate resilience objectives.
