I: Introduction and background

- ❖ CMA 1 considered initial recommendations provided by AC/LEG on the methodologies and invited further technical work and submissions
- ❖ AC and LEG, in collaboration with the SCF, were invited to continue compiling existing methodologies
- ❖ AC 18 considered a compilation of existing methodologies to review the adequacy and effectiveness of adaptation and support, including initial observations, lessons learned, gaps and challenges



II: Overview

- ❖ No further submissions received since AC 18
- ❖ The compilation has been divided into an overview note and a technical annex whereby
 - The overview note contains
 - ✓ the observations from the compilation of methodologies
 - ✓ considerations on the way the technical work of the AC and the LEG could be taken forward so as to contribute towards reviewing the adequacy and effectiveness of adaptation and support as part of the global stocktake (GST)
 - ✓ possible next steps
 - The annex contains the original technical document revised according to comments received from AC members intersessionally



III. Next steps

- ❖ The AC and the LEG, in collaboration with the SCF, may wish to
 - Initiate discussions on the way forward in contributing to the technical work of developing methodologies and in making recommendations on reviewing the adequacy and effectiveness of adaptation and support referred to in Article 7, para. 14 (c), of the Paris Agreement
 - Continue compiling existing methodologies as part of the Adaptation Knowledge Platform to complement the information basis
 - Consider establishing a thematic expert group to solicit additional insights and ideas on reviewing the adequacy and effectiveness of adaptation and support in the context of Article 7, para 14(c) and consider organizing a meeting of this group in the first half of 2021
 - Request the secretariat to publish the annex to this note as a knowledge product
