



Challenges and solutions for overcoming readiness and capacity gaps

Challenges:

- Smallholder farmers and (M)SMEs, as key actors in the global agri-food sector, often lack sufficient access to adaptation finance
- Market-rate products often carry too high interest rates

Opportunities:

- <u>Local</u>: Enhancing the financial and climate literacy and matching financial products to sociocultural environment; making climate data widely available; exchange of experience between lenders and borrowers; combining public and private-sector financing
- <u>National</u>: early engagement of the private sector in NAP process; capacity-building and brokering between lenders and borrowers; building required infrastructure and technologies; ensuring overall enabling environment, including involvement of vulnerable groups; supporting risk management efforts in the agri-food sector
- <u>Global:</u> enhancing availability of climate data and information; building capacity for using data and establishing the business case; combining financial and technical assistance; sharing of global experiences, lessons and progress for inspiration and innovation
