Draft Decision text

*The Conference of the Parties*

*Recalling* Articles 3 and 4 of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change,  
*Also recalling* decisions 1/CP.16 paragraph 20, and 11/CMA.1 paragraph 1,  
*Further recalling* decisions 2/CP.17 paragraph 96,

Welcomes Adaptation Committee report;

Welcomes the progress of the AC in implementing its flexible workplan for 2022-2024;

*Notes* the need for the AC to improve its modalities in selecting themes and topics for its activities, such as workshops, technical papers, forums..., including for the next synthesis report on the recognition of adaptation efforts for developing countries;

*Expresses* concerns about the unbalanced use and insertion of case studies in the AC Policy Brief on progress, good practices and lessons learned, and challenges and opportunities in the application of traditional knowledge, knowledge of Indigenous Peoples and local knowledge systems to adaptation, prepared by the NAP task-force;

*Invites* relevant constituted bodies and representatives of institutional arrangements under the Convention and the Paris Agreement, Parties and non-Party stakeholders, as appropriate, to use any relevant findings from AC deliverables in their work;

*Takes* note of the flexible workplan of the AC for 2025–2027.
