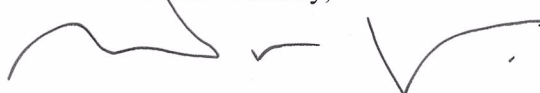
In relation to the decision 1/CMA.7, entitled “*Global Mutirão: Uniting humanity in a global mobilization against climate change*”, Parties established a two-year work programme on climate finance, including on Article 9, paragraph 1, of the Paris Agreement in the context of Article 9 of the Paris Agreement as a whole and decided that the work programme will be facilitated by co-chairs, one from a developed country and one from a developing country.¹ In consultation with the respective constituencies, I am pleased to appoint you as co-chairs of the work programme.

In facilitating the work programme, I encourage you to conduct work in an inclusive, participatory, and transparent manner, fostering broader participation of Parties and stakeholders and considering other relevant ongoing work and processes under the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement, as appropriate. I also encourage you to prepare a work plan to provide predictability and clarity with inputs from Parties and stakeholders and to reflect the outcomes of this engagement on a dedicated page on the UNFCCC website.

I also encourage you to work closely with my team from the COP30 Presidency as well as the incoming COP31 Presidency and the UNFCCC secretariat.

I wish you success in your work and assure you of the Presidency’s full support.
