

## Curriculum vitae – Ng Shao Hua



Mr Ng Shao Hua is Senior Manager (Global Partnerships) at the National Climate Change Secretariat, in the Prime Minister’s Office, Singapore.

In his role, he drives Singapore’s climate change cooperation with international partners, with a focus on advancing high-integrity carbon markets. He serves as Singapore’s Article 6 negotiator, technical lead for the Coalition to Grow Carbon Markets, and on the Council of Climate Action Data Trust. Apart from these responsibilities, he is also involved in advancing Singapore’s carbon markets strategy and policy. This includes implementing some of Singapore’s Article 6.2 bilateral Implementation Agreements.

Previously, he was at the Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore working on sustainable aviation policy. His role included serving as an advisor to the Singapore Member on the International Civil Aviation Organization’s (ICAO) Committee on Aviation Environmental Protection, and Singapore’s focal point for the ICAO Carbon Offsetting and Reduction Scheme for International Aviation.

Shao Hua graduated from the National University of Singapore with a Bachelor of Environmental Studies.
