Statement for GST Informal Consultations
7 of June

1. Thank you Co-facilitators and Colleagues.
2. Chile has a comment regarding the footnote 'b' on page 10 of the non paper¹ regarding the Periodic Assessment. We would like to bring to your attention the importance of the Periodic Assessment as a source of information to the GST and to the the guiding questions reflected on para 11 to 13 of the note².
3. The scope of the Periodic Assessment has 2 elements:
 - a. 'The effectiveness of the Technology Mechanism in supporting the implementation of the Paris Agreement on matters relating to technology development and transfer'; and
 - b. 'The adequacy of support provided to the Technology Mechanism in supporting the implementation of the Paris Agreement on matters relating to technology development and transfer'
4. Also, decision 16 CMA 1 already states that:
 - a. 'The Periodic Assessment should serve as an input to the global stocktake referred to in Article 14 of the Paris Agreement;'
 - b. 'Decides that the outcome of the periodic assessment should guide improved effectiveness and enhanced support to the Technology Mechanism in supporting the implementation of the Paris Agreement;'
5. Taking into consideration that you will further develop the non paper for Glasgow, we kindly ask you to update the current classification and role of the Periodic Assessment as a source of input. It seems extremely relevant for the guiding questions on para 11 to 13 on the no paper, as we previously noted. The current classification as "(f) Barriers and challenges, including finance, technology and capacity building gaps, faced by developing countries" on page 10 might not quite capture its full scope as a source.

11. What are the barriers and challenges, including finance, technology development and transfer and capacity-building gaps, faced by developing countries (§36(f))?
12. What is the state of progress on provision of means of implementation and support and mobilization and provision of support, including the information referred to in Article 9, paragraphs 4 and 6, Article 10, paragraph 6, Article 11, paragraph 3, and Article 13, in particular paragraphs 9 and 10, of the Paris Agreement (§36(d))? 30 For example, the most effective climate and non-climate policies and measures and the circumstances under which they are effective. 31 See the definition of global warming in the glossary of the IPCC SR1.5.
13. What is the overall progress made towards achieving the long-term vision on the importance of fully realizing technology development and transfer in order to improve resilience to climate change and to reduce greenhouse gas emissions referred in Article 10.1? What is the state of cooperative action on technology development and transfer (Article 10.2)?"
