**Twenty-second meeting of the Executive Committee of the Warsaw International Mechanism for  
Loss and Damage associated with Climate Change Impacts, Bonn, Germany**

**13–15 May 2025**

**Note by the task force on displacement for item 10**

1. The table below sets out a draft fourth plan of action of the task force on displacement, which identifies the work of the task force that will contribute to the implementation of the work of the ExCom related to human mobility associated with the impacts of climate change and ‘related to averting, minimizing and addressing displacement related to the adverse impacts of climate change, including by maximizing synergies among relevant stakeholders and processes.’
2. The ExCom may wish to consider the proposed desired impacts, activities, deliverables, leads and indicative timeframe contained in the table, and provide further guidance, if any, to the task force with a view to finalizing the draft plan of action for endorsement by the ExCom.
