**Re: Your letter to the Supervisory Body dated 17 October 2025**

Dear Mr. Moon,

I would like to thank you for your communication dated 17 October 2025, which has been made available to the Article 6.4 Supervisory Body in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Procedure: Direct Communication with Stakeholders.

I am pleased to inform you that the Supervisory Body, at its twentieth meeting, held from 16-20 February 2025 in Bonn, Germany, clarified that, in the absence of an applicable Article 6.4 mechanism methodology, the project proponent may wish to continue monitoring the relevant parameters in accordance with the applied CDM methodology, Article 6.4 Activity Standard, and other applicable Article 6.4 tools, to ensure continuity of monitoring of project activities, but that monitoring of these parameters shall not be construed as:

- a. Allowing a CDM methodology to be applicable to the activity beyond the expiry of the crediting period or 31 December 2025 whichever is earlier.
- b. Conferring any entitlement or assurance regarding the issuance of emission reductions or net removals achieved during this period.

In addition, the Supervisory Body has mandated the secretariat to undertake an analysis of the affected transitioning CDM cases and to present its findings for consideration by the Supervisory Body at its future meeting.
