



Twenty-second meeting of the Executive Committee of the Warsaw International Mechanism for Loss and Damage associated with Climate Change Impacts

13–15 May 2025

Bonn, Germany

The 22nd meeting of the ExCom will take place at the Hotel Collegium Leoninum which is situated at the Bonn city center.

Opening hours of the registration counter

For in-person participants, registration will take place next to the entrance of the meeting room as from 08:00 a.m. Signage to the ExCom 22 meeting will be available at the hotels' main entrance. All registered observers will receive their conference badge for the duration of the meeting at the registration desk.

How to get to the meeting venue

The address to the Hotel Collegium Leoninum is Noeggerathstrasse 34 53111 Bonn. Please see a detailed map below.

Arrival by train

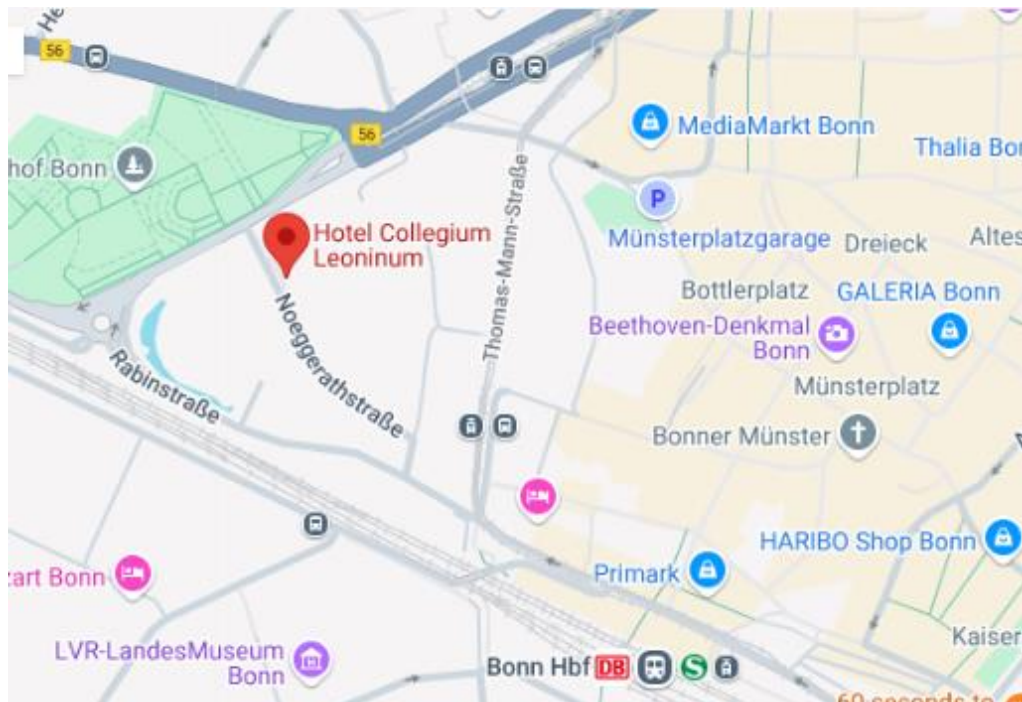
Leave the main train station (Bonn Hbf) towards the center and keep left. Walk 250 m to the left along the street at the main train station, then cross Thomas-Mann-Straße and continue until Noeggerathstraße turns right. Take the leg of Noeggerathstrasse that turns left. Follow the road. After another 100 m you will find the Hotel Collegium Leoninum on the right side of the street.

Arrival by car

From the Bonn Nord motorway junction take the A 555 towards Bonn Zentrum. At the end of the motorway, drive into the roundabout and take the second exit into Heinrich-Böll-Ring. Follow the road for approx. 1.5 km and then turn right into Noeggerathstrasse.

Getting to Bonn

Arriving by plane

From Cologne/Bonn airport:

By bus: To get to Bonn by public transport, take the SB 60 bus which leaves from the airport terminal to Bonn central station every 30 minutes on weekdays, and every 30 to 60 minutes on weekends. The 25 km bus journey from the airport takes about 30 minutes. The stop for the bus to Bonn is located at Terminal 1. The price of a one-way bus ticket to Bonn is around 8 Euros. Tickets may be purchased from the driver or at a ticket machine. From Bonn Central Station, the UN Campus can be reached by bus or by subway (see directions below). During weekdays, the bus departs every 10 minutes while it departs every 30/60 minutes on Saturdays and Sundays. For exact timetables, please refer to the SWB website [here](#).

By taxi: Taxis are readily available. A one-way journey to the city center or the UN Campus costs between 50 and 60 EUR.

From Duesseldorf airport:

Take the sky train to the station "Duesseldorf Flughafen". From there, direct trains to Bonn Central Station leave every hour. For train departures, [check the website of the German railway](#). Type in "Duesseldorf Flughafen" as the departure station and "Bonn Hbf" (Bonn Central Station) as the arrival station. A second-class train ticket costs around 15-20 EUR one way. From Bonn Central Station, the UN Campus can be reached by bus or by subway (see directions below).



From Frankfurt airport:

Go to the Frankfurt airport long-distance train station by following the signs to "Frankfurt Flughafen Fernbahnhof". This station is located at the AIRail Terminal next to Terminal 1. Trains depart from platforms 4 to 7. You can travel either by high-speed Inter City Express (ICE) train to Bonn/Siegburg or by direct train to Bonn Hbf (Central Station). Both trains leave from the Frankfurt airport long-distance train station two to three times every hour between 5 a.m. and 9 p.m. For exact train departures, [check the website of the German railway](#).

ICE to Siegburg/Bonn: The high-speed train journey takes 40 minutes, and trains leave at least once an hour.

From Siegburg/Bonn, you can reach Bonn city centre or the UN Campus both by taxi (20-30 mins) or subway line 66 (30-40 mins). A one-way journey by taxi from Siegburg to Bonn costs approximately 45 EUR.

Direct train to Bonn Central Station: The Intercity (IC)/Eurocity (EC) train, also leaving from the Frankfurt long-distance train station, goes directly to Bonn Central Station. Travel time is between 1.5 and 2 hours. From Bonn Central Station, the UN Campus can be reached by bus or by subway (see directions below).
