Comments received from Mr. Mattias Frumerie, an SCF member

A more action-oriented approach could be achieved through labelling the sub-themes "From policy to action and implementation" or "Enabling climate action: gender-responsive climate finance".

Furthermore, some questions which could be explored:

- How come we have so many policies for gender-responsive climate finance, but still only one percent of climate finance is actually gender-responsive? What are the barriers?
- What steps need to be taken to ensure finance actually integrates gender equality and that gender equality indeed is used as a tool for accelerating climate action?
- What elements does the NCQG need to include to be gender-responsive?
- What elements need to be taken into account when implementing Article 2.1.c of the Paris Agreement to ensure gender-responsiveness?
