The secretariat refers to the forthcoming sixty-fourth sessions of the Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice and the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SB 64) to be held from **8 – 18 June 2026** at the [World Conference Center Bonn](#) (WCCB), Platz der Vereinten Nationen 2, 53113 Bonn, Germany and wishes to inform intergovernmental organizations (IGOs) and non-governmental organizations (NGOs) that the online registration system (ORS) (available at <https://onlinereg.unfccc.int/>) is now open for IGOs and NGOs to register participants for virtual only participation in the sessions.

Each observer organization will be allocated a quota of 10 virtual participants. The Virtual-only tab to register for virtual participation will remain open until **7 June 2026, 23:59** Central European Summer Time (CEST).

Please note that online access will be limited to official plenary sessions, press conferences and negotiation meetings and mandated events only. Virtual participation in other events, such as side events, will not be available through the platform. In addition, mandated events, as well as plenary meetings and press conferences will be publicly available via the UNFCCC website.

Delegates who have already been registered for onsite participation at SB 64 will be able to participate both physically in-person and virtually via the online platform.

Distribution: To all intergovernmental and non-governmental organizations admitted as observers by the Conference of the Parties. To all non-governmental organizations provisionally admitted by the Bureau of the Conference of the Parties.
