## **MESSAGE TO ADMITTED NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS**

### **The Second Global Dialogue on the impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures**

**and**

### **the Thirteenth Meeting of Katowice Committee on Impacts of Implementation of Response Measures**

**29 September–3 October 2025, Istanbul, Türkiye**

On behalf of the Chair of the Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) His Excellency Mr. Adonia Ayebare, and the Chair of the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI), Ms. Julia Gardiner, I am pleased to invite constituencies of admitted non-governmental organizations (NGOs) to participate in the second Global dialogue on the impacts of the implementation of response measures and the thirteenth meeting of the Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of implementation of response measures. These events are being organized in partnership with United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) Istanbul Regional Hub.

The second Global Dialogue will take place **from 29 to 30 September 2025**. The dialogue will be held in conjunction with the three-day thirteenth meeting of the Katowice Committee on Impacts scheduled for **1 to 3 October 2025**. Both events will take place in a hybrid format, allowing for both in-person and virtual participation, with the in-person element taking place in Istanbul. The Chairs of the Subsidiary Bodies (SB Chairs) are grateful to UNDP Istanbul Regional Hub for partnering with UNFCCC to organize these events in Istanbul. These events are being organized in pursuant to decision 13/CP.28, decision 4/CMP.18, and decision 19/CMA.5, whereby COP, CMP and CMA decided to organize a two-day global dialogue on the impacts of the implementation of response measures in conjunction with intersessional meetings of the Katowice Committee on Impacts in 2024

and 2025, in collaboration with relevant organizations and stakeholders and acknowledging the work that has been carried out by the Katowice Committee on Impacts.

### **Topic of the Dialogue**

Pursuant to the same decisions, the SB Chairs will decide on and communicate the topics to be discussed at the dialogue, taking into consideration the submissions received by 15 July, no later than four weeks (1 September 2025), in advance of the global dialogue.

### **Nomination and registration**

The Constituency Focal Points are invited to nominate two in-person participants and up to four representatives for virtual participation via the active virtual participation modality and submit their list of nominations via [cool@unfccc.int](mailto:cool@unfccc.int) by **Monday, 1 September 2025**, at the latest. In view of the need to confirm the arrangements for the meetings as early as possible, please be advised that the secretariat will not be able to process observer registrations received after this deadline.

Further information on nomination and registration will be communicated through the appropriate channels as it becomes available. It is strongly encouraged to nominate experts or practitioners who would substantively enrich the discussions, benefit from, and contribute to the engagement within their national context.

For those interested in following the global dialogue and the thirteenth meeting of the Katowice Committee on Impacts without actively participating, it will also be webcast live.
