Pursuant to the rules of procedure of the Technology Executive Committee, contained in [annex II to decision 4/CP.17](#), I am pleased to notify constituencies of admitted non-governmental organizations of the following meetings:

- **The 31st meeting of the Technology Executive Committee**, to be held in Bonn, from 9 to 11 September 2025, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., Central European Summer Time (CEST);
- **The joint session of the Technology Executive Committee and the Advisory Board of the Climate Technology Centre and Network**, to be held in Bonn, on 12 September 2025, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., CEST.

The meetings will be open to admitted non-governmental organizations (NGOs) in accordance with the above-mentioned decision. In accordance with decision 23/CP.18 and with a view to informing more effective climate change policy that addresses the needs of women and men equally, the UNFCCC secretariat encourages the nomination of women participants.

Nominations for the NGO category should be communicated to the secretariat by Constituency Focal Points (CFPs). Representatives of admitted NGOs nominated by constituency focal points must register using the online registration form, which will be communicated to the nominated participants.

Kindly note, that owing to the limited capacity of the venue, two representatives per constituency will be permitted to participate in person. However, meetings will be webcast through

the UNFCCC website. Constituency focal points are requested to submit their nomination list by 6 p.m. on **Friday, 1 August 2025, CEST** at the latest via cool@unfccc.int.

In view of the need to confirm the arrangements for the meetings as early as possible, observer registrations for non-governmental organizations received after this deadline may not be processed.
