## Annotations to the provisional agenda

### 1. Opening of the meeting

1. The 37<sup>th</sup> meeting of the enforcement branch of the Compliance Committee of the Kyoto Protocol will be opened by the chairperson of the branch.

2. Members and alternate members of the branch will be invited to introduce themselves briefly.

### 3. Adoption of the agenda and organization of work

3. In conformity with rule 7 of the rules of procedure of the Committee<sup>1</sup>, the branch will be invited to consider and adopt the provisional agenda for this meeting, annotated in the present document (document CC/EB/37/2022/1).

4. The branch will also be invited to consider the indicative schedule to conduct its work, as presented by the chairperson of the branch, for agreement.

### 4. Consideration of the question of implementation with respect to Kazakhstan

5. At its 36<sup>th</sup> meeting, the branch considered the first and second progress reports submitted by Kazakhstan<sup>2</sup> in accordance with paragraph 29 of the preliminary finding<sup>3</sup> and paragraph 6 of the final decision<sup>4</sup>, and noted that it looks forward to receiving information in further progress reports and in the national inventory report of Kazakhstan to be submitted in 2022<sup>5</sup>. Kazakhstan submitted its third progress report<sup>6</sup> on 4 February 2022.

6. The branch will be invited to consider a presentation by the secretariat summarizing the current status regarding the question of implementation with respect to Kazakhstan<sup>7</sup>.

7. The branch will also be invited to consider a presentation by Kazakhstan and to deliberate on how to proceed with the reviews of the plans and any adoption of the decision on the plans.
