Subject: Stakeholder consultation – A6.4 mechanism registry.

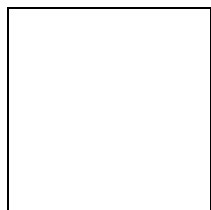
■ Respected Colleague,

Please find below the inputs for the A 6.4 mechanism registry :

1. Issuance and Distribution : No where in the section, the timeline for issuance and distribution is mentioned. This needs to be included for ease of end users to the registry.
2. In section of cancellations : A Party, or public or private entity, having a holding account in the mechanism registry may transfer AERs in its holding account to the account for voluntary cancellation of AERs for OMGE in the mechanism registry referred to in paragraph 14(e) of the registry - If this is the case then what shall happen to the ITMOS, if OMGE was the sole criteria to be achieved. Why sell off ITMOS is being created at the carbon exchange. Only OMGE shall suffice.
3. Reporting and Transparency - The total amount of A6.4ERs issued, AERs, MCUs and CERs cancelled mandatorily and voluntarily by cancellation type and purpose, and AERs and CERs retired in the reporting period and the accumulated amount since the beginning of the first report (statement provided by the draft registry) - It will be good option to include the minimum and maximum of CERs that are allowed for issuance and cancellation including sale off and retirement. (cap value for CERs allowed) it will help in resolving insolvency as well as enable entities to ward off hard to abate emissions.
4. Transfer of CERs : transfer the AERs, MCUs and/or CERs in its holding account to another account(s) - timeline and guideline not mentioned. What shall be the time stipulated for transfer.
