# Procedural background

• **SB 010** agreed to establish a forum of the Article 6.4 DNAs to support the implementation of the Article 6.4 mechanism and to facilitate a dialogue with host Parties and to report accordingly.



# Purpose

 The purpose is to provide an update to the Supervisory Body regarding the activities undertaken and planned in relation to the Article 6.4 DNAs.



## 104 Parties designated and communicated

- African (41): Benin, Botswana, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cabo Verde, Cameron, Central Africa Republic, Chad, Congo, Côte d'Ivoire, DR Congo, Egypt, Ethiopia, Eswatini, Gabon, Gambia, Ghana, Guinea, Kenya, Lesotho, Liberia, Madagascar, Malawi, Mali, Mauritania, Mauritius, Morocco, Namibia, Niger, Nigeria, Rwanda, Sao Tome and Principe, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Seychelles, Somalia, Togo, Tunisia, Uganda, Zambia and Zimbabwe.
- Asia-Pacific (30): Bangladesh, Bhutan, Cambodia, China, Republic of Korea, Fiji, India, Indonesia, Iraq, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Lao People's Democratic Republic, Maldives, Mongolia, Myanmar, Nepal, Oman, Pakistan, Palau, Papua New Guinea, Philippines, Saudi Arabia, State of Palestine, Solomon Islands, Sri Lanka, Timor- Leste, United Arab Emirates, Uzbekistan, Vanuatu and Viet Nam.

- Eastern European States (4): Azerbaijan, Czechia, Estonia, and Ukraine.
- Latin America and Caribbean States (18): Argentina, Bahamas, Belize, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Mexico, Nicaragua, Panama, Paraguay, Peru and Uruguay.
- Western European and other States (8): Finland, France, Greece, Liechtenstein, New Zealand, Sweden, Switzerland and Turkiye.



#### Continued

As of 12 May 2025, 16 Parties have submitted the Host Party Participation Requirements

- Asia-Pacific (7): Bangladesh, Benin, Bhutan, India, Myanmar, Nepal, and Sri Lanka
- Latin America and Caribbean States (2): Chile, and Dominican Republic
- African (7): Ghana, Madagascar, Mali, Morocco, Rwanda, Togo, and Uganda.
- Of these, 6 Parties have submitted host Party approval for certain CDM projects or programmes of activities that have requested a transition to the Article 6.4 mechanism: Bangladesh (11), Bhutan (3), Dominican Republic (3), Ghana (2), Myanmar (4), and Uganda (13). A total of 36 approvals.
- No statement of authorization on the use of A6.4 ERs has been received.



- Secretariat has been reaching out to all Parties to designate and communicate their national authority for the mechanism and the submission of host Party participation requirement, as well as the host Party approval.
- Secretariat has sent out another round of reminders to host Parties who
  may wish to submit approvals for activities eligible for transition to the
  Article 6.4 mechanism.
- RCCs experts are also engaged with UNFCCC national focal points and Article 6.4 DNAs to ensure the designation of DNAs and the submission of the host Party Participation Requirements as well as the submission of host Party approvals.



#### Continued

 Regional workshops that targeted DNAs, as part of the Article 6 capacitybuilding programme, were also conducted and more details to be provided during the update on the Agenda item 5. Para 34.



#### Planned activities

- The first Global DNA Forum will be held in Panama on 20 and 22 May 2025.
  - More than 60 Parties have confirmed their participation
  - A total of 100 participants will be expected
  - Will serve as the official launch of the Article 6.4 Global DNA Forum with the election of Chair and Vice-Chair.
- Regional workshops that will target all DNAs, as part of the Article 6 capacity-building programme and more details to be provided during the update on the Agenda item 5. Para 34.
- Webinars for Article 6.4 DNAs to update DNAs on the recent developments, decisions of the SBM and time-sensitive issues.



# Recommendation to the Supervisory Body

The secretariat recommends that the Supervisory Body takes note
of the updates on activities related to the DNAs and provide any
necessary guidance.
