**Matters relating to the forum on the impact of the implementation of
response measures**

The Conference of the Parties, Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol, Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement

Recalling decisions 7/CP.24, 3/CMP.14, 7/CMA.1, 4/CP.25, 4/CMP.15, 4/CMA.2, and 19/CMA.1.

1. *Welcomes with appreciation* the informal event and technical expert meetings in 2020 and 2021¹ organized by the Chairs of the Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) and the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) serving as inputs to the forum's work on implementing the relevant activities of the workplan of the forum on the impact of the implementation of response measures and its Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures (hereinafter referred to as the workplan)²;

2. *Welcomes* the annual reports of the Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures (KCI) for 2019, 2020, 2020–2021^{3,4} and KCI's progress in supporting the work of the forum on the impact of the implementation of response measures;

3. *Welcomes* the progress made by the KCI in implementing the workplan and the inputs from experts, practitioners and relevant organisations that served as inputs into the Forum and its KCI's work.

4. *Notes* the lack of gender balance among KCI membership and encourages regional groups to consider gender balance while nominating KCI members.

5. *Encourages* the forum to progress implementation of its work programme in accordance with its functions, work programme, and modalities⁵, and *requests* the secretariat at exceptional basis to organise a workshop in conjunction with SB 56 to further advance the forum's implementation of activities number 2, 4 and 11;

6. *Welcomes* the recommendations and/or key findings on the workplan activities in the KCI meeting reports for consideration by the forum as applicable while implementing the corresponding workplan activities;

7. *Invites* Parties and stakeholders to consider the key messages and recommendations contained in Section III (pertaining to the activity 1 of the workplan) as applicable and adopt the revised rules procedure of the KCI consisted in the Annex of the 2020-2021 annual report of the KCI:

8. *Requests* SBI and SBSTA to continue considering the outstanding elements of the annual reports of the KCI for 2019, 2020 and 2020-2021, including the remaining recommendations

and considerations contained therein, at the fifty-sixth sessions of the subsidiary bodies (June 2022) with a view to providing recommendations for consideration and adoption by the Conference of the Parties, the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol and the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement at their next sessions;

9. *Requests* the secretariat to organize a regional workshop for activity 3 of the workplan before SB56 in collaboration with other relevant organizations and stakeholders, addressing regional needs and acknowledging the work that is being carried out by the KCI; and agreed that any further regional workshop on activity 3 may be decided by the forum.

10. Recalling paragraphs 6b and 37 of the decision 19/CMA.1, *encourages* Parties to submit their views on efforts related to addressing the social and economic consequences and impacts of response measures;

11. In accordance of the decision 4/CMA.2 (workplan activity d) and paragraphs 19 and 26 of the decision 19/CMA.1 *invites* the forum to prepare information for the technical assessment component of the global stocktake related to efforts related to addressing the social and economic consequences and impacts of response measures.

12. *Requests* the secretariat, following the relevant guiding questions provided by SB Chairs according to paragraph 7 of the decision 19/CMA.1 and with the guidance of the KCI, to submit a report (paragraph 37 (d) of the decision 19/CMA.1) reflecting the relevant work of the forum and its KCI by February 2022, as an input to the global stocktake technical assessment that starts at the fifty-sixth sessions of the subsidiary bodies (June 2022)⁶. The inputs to the technical assessment document by the forum include information included in KCI annual reports, KCI meeting reports and, KCI technical papers.
