The UNFCCC Adaptation Committee is seeking expressions of interest from organizations interested in contributing to the organization of the 2020 technical examination process on adaptation (TEP-A), including the 2020 technical expert meeting on adaptation (TEM-A). Under the guidance of the Adaptation Committee, volunteer expert organizations will work with the UNFCCC secretariat to plan and implement the 2020 TEP-A, which will focus on the topic of *Education and training, public participation and youth to enhance adaptation action*. Organizations with expertise related to this year's theme will be invited to help shape the substantive programme of the TEM-A, contribute to shaping a policy case competition and overall outreach and promotional efforts, and generally share their insights into how to make the TEP-A engaging, informative, and successful. This could include, for example, suggesting speakers, assisting with drafting the case study, developing selection and participation criteria, advising on how to run the competition, etc. Volunteer organizations will work with the secretariat to identify which roles or tasks best suit their expertise and capacity.
