

# ROADMAP TO MISSION 1.5 TROIKA MAJLIS

## Enhancing international cooperation

Thursday, 10 October from 10:30 - 11:45 AZT

The “Troika” of UNFCCC COP Presidencies - the United Arab Emirates, the Republic of Azerbaijan, and Brazil - is convening Parties and other stakeholders at the Pre-COP29 to share experiences, best practices and opportunities for enhancing international cooperation and collaboration to enable ambitious climate action and the development and implementation of climate policies in the context of the next round of NDCs, with a view to keeping 1.5°C and global resilience goals within reach.

### Context

The outcome of the first Global Stocktake (GST) and the broader UAE consensus provide a comprehensive roadmap for international cooperation towards accelerating and scaling-up climate action across all actors of society, sectors and regions.

As part of the GST outcome, Parties reaffirmed their commitment to multilateralism, in the light of the progress made under the Paris Agreement and resolved to remain united in the pursuit of efforts to achieve the purpose and long-term goals of the Agreement. Parties further recognized the importance of international collaboration, including transboundary cooperation, for addressing climate change, in the context of sustainable development and poverty eradication, particularly for those who have significant capacity constraints, and enhancing climate action across all actors of society, sectors and regions. Additionally, Parties and non-Party stakeholders were urged to join efforts to accelerate inclusive, multilevel, gender-responsive and cooperative climate action across all sectors and regions.

In the context of its mandate, the Roadmap to Mission 1.5 COP Presidencies Troika remains focused on its objective to significantly enhance international cooperation and the international enabling environment to stimulate ambition in the next round of NDCs. Throughout 2024 the COP Presidencies Troika has hosted a [series of high-level political convenings](#) to stimulate ambition in the next round of NDCs by assessing key barriers and identifying opportunities to strengthen efforts that advance implementation.

### Scope

As the global community prepares for the next round of Nationally Determined Contributions, enhancing international cooperation is crucial to stimulate ambition and ensure the effectiveness of climate action. The Troika is convening Parties and non-Party stakeholders to a Majlis discussion and share experiences and best practices for enhancing international cooperation and collaboration to enable ambitious climate action and the development and implementation of climate policies in the context of the next round of NDCs at the local, subnational, national and regional levels and in transboundary contexts.

## Proposed Guiding Questions for Discussion

The Troika invites participants to focus their interventions on the following areas:

- How do you feature international cooperation and collaboration for climate action and policies to drive ambition in the next generation of NDCs how do you account for transboundary risks and opportunities?
- What enabling conditions are required to enhance international cooperation and collaboration between and among Parties and non-Party stakeholders?
- How do you design cooperation approaches that facilitate the achievement of the UNFCCC ultimate objective, the purpose and long-term goals of the Paris Agreement, and the UAE consensus, in a synergistic and efficient manner with the other Rio Conventions and the Sustainable Development Goals?
