I. Background

- **NAP TF:** established in 2013 to advance and coordinate work on NAPs with other constituted bodies and the operating entities of the Financial Mechanism
- **Members:**
 - AC, LEG, SCF, TEC, AF, GEF and GCF
 - Contributions from others, e.g. CTCN
- **AC21 took note of:**
 - Progress report on the work of the NAP Taskforce and provided further guidance
 - The presentation of the online resource for navigating the landscape of support for the process to formulate and implement NAPs

II. Update since AC21 and reflections

- **The NAP TF:**

- Finalized the AC report on Navigating the landscape of support for the process to formulate and implement NAPs, and the related online resource, which were published this summer

- **Reflections from the NAP TF meeting in July 2022:**

- Members discussed ways to strengthen synergies and coherence of NAP-related activities and provided specific examples of activities that they are conducting to foster coordination

→ Examples of entry points:

- AC's technical work
- Annual meetings with the constituted bodies organized by the GCF Board
- Cross-participation in meetings
- GCF-GEF collaboration
- AC's annual dialogue with adaptation-related constituted bodies

II. Update since AC21 and reflections (continued)

- **NAP Expo 2022 events:**
 - Promoting the inclusion of (micro,) small and medium enterprises in national adaptation planning and implementation (AC, ITC, NAP-GN)
 - Opportunities for gender-responsive adaptation planning and action through NAPs (AC, LEG, NAP-GN)
 - Matching needs with support in formulating and implementing NAPs (AC and LEG)

III. Agreed next steps by the NAP TF

- From the 2022-24 flexible workplan, 2022 ongoing activities:
 - Supporting the AC in developing the technical paper on M&E
 - Developing a policy brief on progress, good practices and lessons learned in prioritizing/ incorporating gender responsive adaptation action
 - Identifying synergies and exploring collaborations in awareness-raising, outreach and information-sharing plans and activities of the members of the Taskforce
- At the meeting in July, the NAP TF also discussed creating an online resource to match gaps and needs in the process to formulate and implement NAPs as identified by the LEG and the AC with support products and activities by constituted bodies and other organizations.
- **The AC will be invited to consider the information presented and possible next steps.**
