Priorities

- Long-term strategic partnership for country and region-specific actions
- Increase knowledge of and ways to protect common ecosystems when taking action to reduce vulnerability and enhance adaptive capacity and resilience
- Provision of technical support to the LEG in supporting Parties on formulating and implementing NAPs
- Provision of technical expertise for implementing the workplans of constituted bodies (region specific, thematic areas, transboundary)

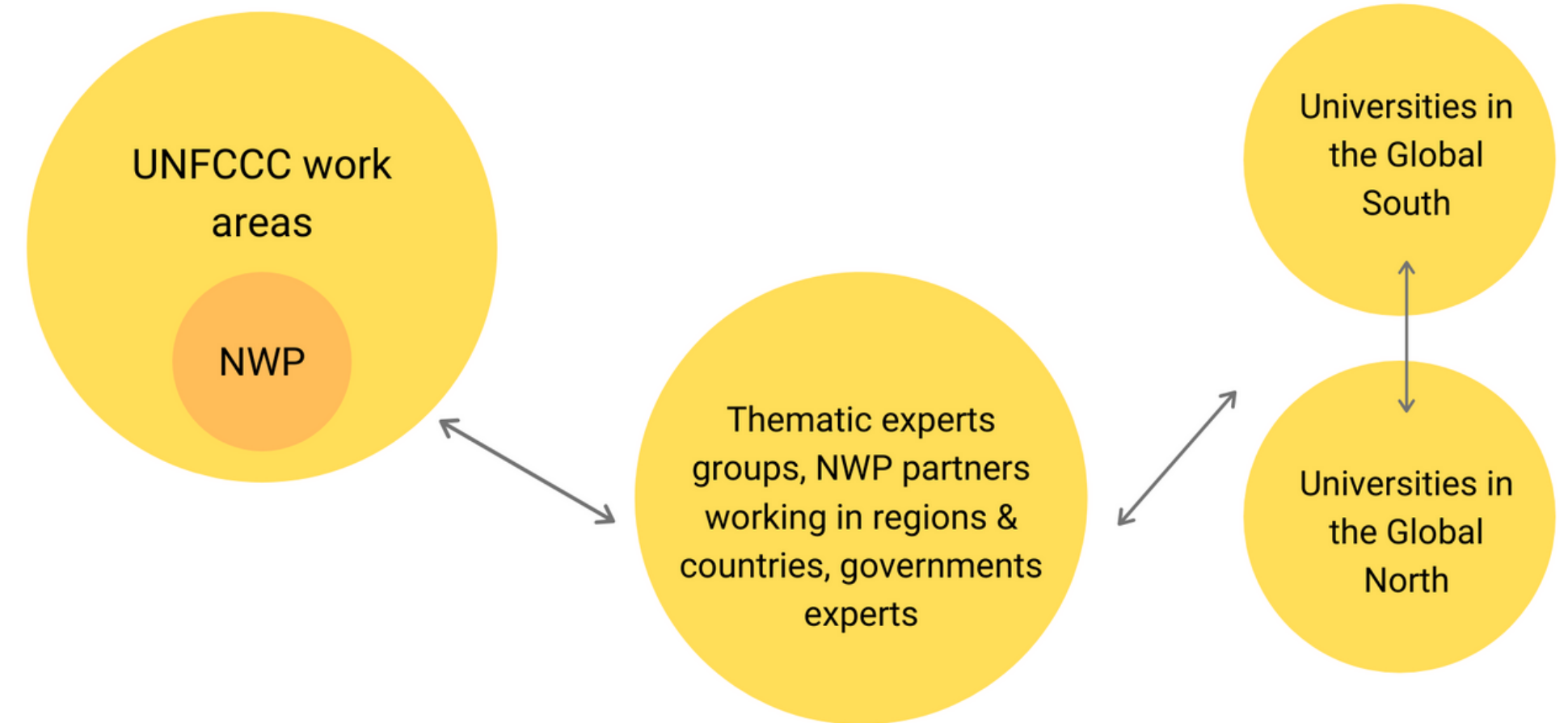
