I. Introduction and background

- The CMA, in its decision **11/CMA.1**, requested the secretariat, under the guidance of the AC and the LEG and in collaboration with relevant stakeholders, to prepare synthesis reports on specific adaptation themes, focusing on relevant lessons learned and good practices in developing country Parties.
- At AC 23, the AC agreed to the topics “Efforts of developing countries institutional arrangements and stakeholder engagement”.
- AC 24 and 25 considered a draft outline for the report, including possible next steps. **AC 25 requested the secretariat to prepare an annotated outline of the report for intersessional consideration by the AC**, a first draft of the report for consideration by AC 26, and a **final draft for intersessional consideration in October 2024**.
- The annotated outline of the report was shared with the AC in July for written feedback.
