

- It requested the AC to report annually to the COP, through the subsidiary bodies, including on its activities and the performance of its functions, guidance, recommendations and other relevant information arising from its work and, as appropriate, on further action that may be required under the Convention for consideration by the COP.
- CMA 1 decided that the AC shall serve the Paris Agreement.

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

- Publishing a policy brief on applying traditional knowledge, knowledge of Indigenous Peoples and local knowledge systems to adaptation (see para. 66 below): Publishing a synthesis report on institutional arrangements and stakeholder
- engagement focused on recognizing adaptation efforts (see para. 48 below): (e) Deciding to publish the first synthesis report on the state of adaptation action by Parties by the end of 2026 (see para. 46 below):
- Continuing to make progress in updating the online resource for navigating the


