I. Opening of the session

(Agenda item 1)

1. The nineteenth session of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol (CMP), convened pursuant to Article 13, paragraph 6, of the Kyoto Protocol, was held at Baku Stadium in Baku, Azerbaijan, from 11 to 22 November 2024. Mukhtar Babayev (Azerbaijan), President of CMP 19, convened the 1st meeting of the session¹ on 11 November.²

A. Adoption of the agenda

2. At its 1st meeting, the CMP considered document FCCC/KP/CMP/2024/1/Add.1, containing the supplementary provisional agenda. The President recalled the understanding reached among Parties outlined at the resumed 1st meeting of the Conference of the Parties at its twenty-ninth session.³
