The secretariat refers to the [Message from the Chairs of the subsidiary bodies](#) dated 29 June 2026 regarding the topic to be discussed at the third Global Dialogue on the impacts of the implementation of response measures taking place from 21 to 22 September 2026 in Bangkok.

Further to the message, the secretariat would like to inform Parties that the following three events will be taking place from **21 to 25 September 2026 in United Nations Conference Centre, Bangkok, Thailand**:

- Third Global Dialogue on impacts of implementation of response measures **(21 - 22 September 2026)**;
- Fifteenth meeting of the Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures (KCI 15) **(23 - 25 September 2026)**;
- Workshop on health co-benefits for advancing NDC implementation **(23 September 2026)**.

These events are open for nomination of Party representatives, as well as the corresponding participation modalities. Mandated events will be organized in accordance with their respective mandates. Information on all events for nomination and funding modalities is provided below.

Distribution: To Parties and observer States through their national focal points and diplomatic missions accredited to the Federal Republic of Germany.



Detailed information on each event will also be made available on the dedicated webpage of the respective event.¹

Participation in events is facilitated through the National Focal Points (NFPs) of Parties and observer States. National Focal Points are invited to nominate representatives in accordance with the modalities outlined below.

Participation modalities

All three events will be held in a hybrid format. Participants may attend either in-person or virtually. KCI 15 will also be webcast live for those interested in following KCI 15 without actively participating.

Nomination modality (non-funded in-person participants and virtual participants)

National Focal Points of interested Parties and observer States are invited to submit nominations via [this link in Indico](#) by Friday, 21 August 2026, at the latest. Through the link, National Focal Points may nominate representatives for:

- **Third Global Dialogue on impacts of implementation of response measures:**
 - In-person participation
 - Virtual participation
- **KCI 15 meeting:**
 - In-person participation as observers
 - Virtual participation as observers
- **Workshop on health co-benefits for advancing NDC implementation:**
 - In-person participation
 - Virtual participation.

Nomination modality (funded in-person participants)

Owing to funding limitations, the secretariat will be able to provide financial support for in-person participation to only a limited number of participants. National Focal Points shall receive further information from their regional focal points on the nomination process. Financial support will not be applicable for participation in the KCI meeting as observers. Once the nomination has been confirmed, nominated in-person participants will be required to complete their registration through a registration link that will be provided by the secretariat.

Party delegates registered for in-person participation and that require a visa to travel to the Thailand are strongly encouraged to contact the competent Thailand mission or consular authorities as soon as possible to allow sufficient time for the necessary visas (and transit visas if required) to be issued.
