Pursuant to the rules of procedure of the Technology Executive Committee, contained in [annex II to decision 4/CP.17](#), I am pleased to notify United Nations organizations and related organization and specialized agencies (UN organizations) and admitted intergovernmental organizations of the following meetings:

- The **30<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Technology Executive Committee**, to be held in Copenhagen, from 1 to 3 April 2025, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. (Central European Summer Time) each day;
- The **joint session of the Technology Executive Committee and the Advisory Board of the Climate Technology Centre and Network**, to be held in Copenhagen, on 4 April 2025, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. (Central European Summer Time).

The meetings will be open to United Nations organizations and admitted observer organizations in accordance with the above-mentioned decision. In accordance with decision 23/CP.18 and with a view to informing more effective climate change policy that addresses the needs of women and men equally, the UNFCCC secretariat encourages the nomination of women participants. Owing to space limitations, access may be limited for in-person participation. However, the meetings will be webcast through the UNFCCC website.
